

ALMA

I Alma Parade (map ref I) Black Sheep Best Bitter; 3 guest beers 31 Sandside (map ref 8) Samuel Smith's OBB Striking, mock-Tudor p

Town centre local with two rooms containing a large and varied collection of memorabilia. The cosy back snug bar retains an olde-worlde character even though it now doubles as a games room.

ANGEL

46 North Street (map ref 2) Copper Dragon Golden Pippin; Tetley Bitter; Taylor Landlord Friendly, one-roomed, town-centre local, with U-shaped bar, displaying an excellent collection of saucy seaside postcards. Impressive array of sports trophies won by the pub's teams. Spacious patio garden at the rear has some interesting wall art.

BARBICAN

4-13 St. Nicholas Street (map ref 3) 4 guest beers

Recently refurbished and transformed into a modern, trendy bar. The large, split-level main bar is divided into several, disabled-friendly eating areas with all day food menus.

BLACK LION

12 North Street (map ref 4) 2 Marston-supplied beers

Traditional, two-roomed, town centre local. Freshly cooked meals are served lunchtimes (except Mon). Live entertainment at weekends.

CASK INN

Cambridge Terrace (map ref 5) Caledonian Golden XPA; Theakston Best Bitter; 3 guest beers Traditional pub on the outskirts of the town centre, with several ground-floor rooms, serving homecooked food throughout the day.

CELLARS

35-37 Valley Road (map ref 6) Camerons Strongarm; Jennings Snecklifter; 4 guest beers; 2 ciders Scarborough's longest consecutive GBG entry (15 years) is a family-run pub converted from the cellars of a Victorian house. Excellent locally sourced, home-cooked food is available lunchtimes and evenings, with Sunday lunches particularly popular.

CROWN TAVERN

8 Scalby Road (map ref 7) Marston's Burton Bitter & Pedi-

gree; 2 other Marston-supplied beers Grade II listed pub about 10 minutes' walk from the town centre. Extensive all day food menu.

GOLDEN BALL

31 Sandside (map ref 8) Samuel Smith's OBB Striking, mock-Tudor pub with fabulous views across the harbour. Multiroomed with a sea-view bar, downstairs bar, family room and a popular beer garden at the rear.

HIGHLANDER

15-16 Esplanade (map ref 9) **Tetley Bitter; Wells Bombardier; Wold Top Bitter; guest beer** An integral part of the Highlander Hotel with a Scottish-themed lounge, cellar bar and carvery. An extensive collection of malt whiskies is on show.

INDIGO ALLEY

4 North Marine Road (map ref 10) 1 Wold Top beer; 2 guest beers; 2 ciders & I perry

Welcoming, bare-boarded, open-plan pub with a rustic feel and a log burner. Local CAMRA runner up Town Pub of the Year 2013. Dog- and child-friendly, with live entertainment every Friday and Saturday.

LEEDS ARMS

26 St. Mary's Street (map ref 11) Copper Dragon Golden Pippin; Taylor Landlord; guest beer Small, thriving, one-roomed, Grade II listed pub situated in the Old Town behind the harbour. Fishing and yachting pictures and memorabilia adorn the walls.

LORD ROSEBERY

85-87 Westborough (map ref 12) Greene King Abbot Ale & Ruddles Best Bitter; 10 guest beers; 3 ciders & 1 perry

Large Wetherspoon's originally built in 1895 as the Scarborough Liberal Headquarters and then acquired by the Co-op after World War II. Busy pub on two levels, each with a bar.

NORTH RIDING

161 North Marine Road (map ref 13) **Taylor Landlord; York Guzzler; 4 guest beers; 1 cider & 1 perry** Scarborough's only brew pub, and current local CAMRA Town Pub of the Year, is host to the North Riding Brewery. The public bar, quiet lounge and upstairs dining room serving home-cooked food, all have real fires.

OLD SCALBY MILLS

Scalby Mills Road (map ref 14) Black Sheep Best Bitter; Copper Dragon Black Gold; I beer from each of Greene King, Scarborough & Wold Top

Originally a watermill, but has seen many uses over the years – old photographs and prints chart its history. Superb views of the North Bay.

RIVELYN HOTEL

I-4 Crown Crescent (map ref I5) **2 Scarborough beers** Comfortably-furnished bar area in this hotel recently acquired by the owners of the Scarborough Brewery and award-winning Valley Bar.

SCHOLARS

6 Somerset Terrace (map ref 16) Copper Dragon Golden Pippin; Hambleton Nightmare; Theakston Lightfoot; York Yorkshire Terrier; 3 guest beers; 2 ciders

Warm, friendly atmosphere at this town-centre pub – local CAMRA runner up Town Pub of the Year 2013. It has a large front bar and a games room. Numerous screens show major sporting events.

SPA

45 Victoria Road (map ref 17) **Tetley Bitter; 3 guest beers** Recently refurbished, popular local whose single main room has several drinking areas and a games section.

TAP & SPILE

Regular live entertainment.

94 Falsgrave Road (map ref 18) Black Sheep Best Bitter; Camerons Strongarm; Taylor Landlord; Theakston Old Peculier; guest beer Sympathetically restored, Grade II listed pub with a friendly atmosphere. It has two main rooms plus a small snug. Regular live music.

TENNYSON ARMS

69-71 Dean Road (map ref 19) Tetley Bitter; Wychwood Hobgoblin; guest beer

Traditional, two-roomed, familyfriendly local comprising lounge bar and tap room with darts and pool. Live entertainment at weekends.

VALLEY

51 Valley Road (map ref 20) Dark Star Hophead; Theakston Best Bitter; 4 guest beers; 8 ciders & 1 perry

Cellar bar offering mainly microbrewery beers, usually including one or more from Scarborough Brewery. Upstairs rooms offer additional seating and a pool table. CAMRA National Cider Pub of the Year 2007.
